1. The Islamic University in Uganda (IUIU) has received financing from the Islamic Development Bank toward the cost of the Enhancing the Learning Environment at the Islamic University in Uganda Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for design and supervision consultancy services.

The services include:

2. The preparation of designs and supervision consultancy services for the Construction and Equipping of a new faculty of engineering, a hostel and a new Library at the IUIU Mbale Campus in Uganda to improve the quality of the learning environment.

The varied scope of work shall include the following components:

- i. One 500 bed capacity (Male) hostel including a kitchen and dining facilities.
- ii. A library building – The library concept is continually changing due to the evolving methods of providing, managing and delivering information resources.
- iii. A faculty of engineering with the following disciplines (Civil, Electrical and Mechanical Engineering) with lecture rooms, laboratories, workshops and associated storage and offices

iv. External works and landscaping

Note that the hostel, the library and the faculty of engineering buildings will be fully furnished with appropriate furniture.

The subject consultancy services shall be implemented over a period of 30 months from the estimated commencement date of 2021 for the design and supervision services. The detailed Terms of Reference TOR for this assignment shall be obtained from the address given below.

3. IUIU now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to express their interest in providing the services. Interested Consultants must provide specific information which demonstrates that they are fully qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.).

The shortlisting criteria will include:

- Firms shall present proof of performance of similar assignments and as such their core business with established structures to execute the assignment
- Acceptable professional and technical capacity of firms
- At least two successfully completed similar assignments in the last seven years
- No history of poor performing contracts evidenced by client recommendation letters

Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage

4. The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Paragraphs, 1.23, and 1.24 of the Guidelines for Procurement of Consultant Services under Islamic Development Bank Project Financing (the “Procurement Guidelines”), setting forth IsDB’s policy on conflict of interest.
5. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.
6. A consultant will be selected in accordance with Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method – firms from the domestic/ national shortlist as set out in the Procurement Guidelines.
